





WHO/NTD Skin-NTDs, Disability management and inclusion

- Promote and monitor the provision of and appropriate integrated care and rehabilitation services for those affected by skin-NTD-associated morbidity, disability and stigmatization;
- Develop WHO guidance on skin NTDs and related disabilities;
- Promote research and communicate priorities for research on skin-NTDs and morbidity management
- Lead the preparation of products that **translate WHO guidance from policy to practice**, where warranted, to support health-care workers and related workforces in health education, active case detection and management; and
- Promote the global integrated skin-NTD strategy and related disability and stigmatization issues at all levels.



Strategic Framework for Integrated Control of Skin-NTDs

Purpose

- Global document with options for country and local adaptation based on disease epidemiology
- Programmatic document to guide and support ministries of health on integrated control of skin-NTDs
- Focus on the delivery of services at the PHC level covering key diseases and cross-cutting areas to contribute to achieve UHC 2030
- Wide consultation with all relevant stakeholders through online questionnaire and direct telephone discussions with selected experts (same procedure used for the WHO NTD Roadmap consultation)

Skin-NTD @ WHO – Further work

- Establish a sub-group of the NTD Diagnostic Technical Advisory Group to focus on **laboratory and diagnostic aspects of Skin-NTDs**
- Plan to establish an WHO Advisory Group on Skin-NTDs to guide programmatic implementation
- Establish a database of experts for each NTD and some cross-cutting areas
- Establish a **photo library** to support teaching
- Skin-NTDs included in the new NTD Roadmap which will give some visibility
 - Integration
 - Common platform approach
